SET OF PUZZLES OF THE 10 EMOTIONS

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CONTENTS:

The game comprises 10 puzzles and 10 model cards made from thick, strong, high quality cardboard.

DESCRIPTION OF THE CONTENTS

- 10 large puzzles showing photos of children and adults experiencing different emotions. The puzzles are progressive with 3, 4 and 6 pieces. The back of each puzzle is in a different colour to make it easy to recognise and group the pieces of the same puzzle. Puzzle dimensions: 15.6 x 15.6 cm.
- 10 model cards: one side features the same images as the puzzles of each emotion and the other side contains an icon representing that emotion. Dimensions of the cards: $5.8 \times 5.8 \text{ cm}$.
- The 10 emotions represented are:
 - 1. Happiness
 - 2. Self-confidence
 - 3. Admiration
 - 4. Curiosity
 - 5. Surprise
 - 6. Anger
 - 7. Disgust
 - 8. Sadness
 - 9. Fear
 - 10. Guilt

RECOMMENDED AGES:

2-6 years old.

We recommend that children aged 2 and 3 work with an adult who can help them to put the puzzles together. Children aged 5 to 6 can work more independently, starting with the puzzles with fewer pieces.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES:

- To develop observational skills.
- To improve psychomotor coordination and manual skills by handling the pieces and fitting them together correctly.
- o To develop and enlarge basic vocabulary relating to the images on the puzzles.





METHOD OF PLAY AND ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Choose the model card of the emotion whose puzzle you are going to put together.
- 2. Group all the pieces of that puzzle together. You can easily identify them as each puzzle has a different colour on the back.
- 3. Once all the pieces have been grouped, put together the puzzle using the model card as a guide.
