Getting started with the Remote Control Light Up Vehicle

The Remote Control Light Up Vehicle is a rechargeable, remote-controlled vehicle designed for use in early years and educational settings. Combining simple directional control with engaging light up features, it allows children to explore movement, direction and cause and effect in a visual way while using subtle technology. With multiple colour modes, built in safety features and compatibility with other Glow accessories, the vehicle is interactive, easy-to-use and well suited to floor-based play and group activities.

The Remote Control Light Up Vehicle has been tested for ages **10 months upwards**.

What's included?

- 1 vehicle
- 1 remote control
- 2 charging cables (same version of charger for vehicle and remote and control)
- 1 x quick visual guide



First things first – charging the vehicle and remote

Before using the Remote Control Light Up Vehicle, ensure that both the vehicle and the remote control are fully charged.

Charging the vehicle

- Use the charging port (found underneath the vehicle) and cable provided.
- The car takes approximately 4 hours to charge.
- Once fully charged, the car will run for approximately 3 hours.
- The car will glow red to show that it is charging and turn green when fully charged.

Charging the remote control

- Use the charging port (found on the bottom on the remote control) and cable provided.
- The remote control takes approximately 2 hours to charge.
- Once charged, the remote will run for approximately 20 hours.
- The light above the joystick will flash red when charging and turn to green when fully charged.

How to switch the vehicle on

- Turn the vehicle on using the switch located underneath the car.
- The vehicle will flash green to show it is switched on and ready to pair.

Pairing the remote control to the vehicle

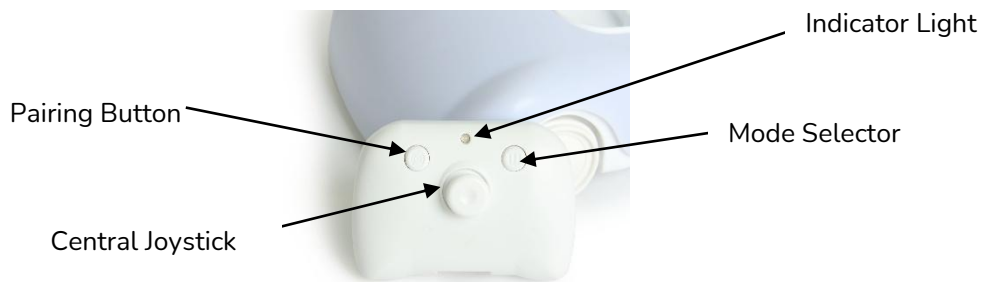
1. Turn the remote control on using the switch on the bottom of the controller.
2. Ensure the vehicle is switched on.
3. Press the pairing button which can be found on the left-hand side of the joystick (wireless symbol).
4. The vehicle will change to a solid green glow once pairing is successful and the green flashing light above the joystick on the control will turn solid green.

The vehicle and remote control are now ready to use.

Features of the remote control

The remote control has been designed to be simple so that young children can use it with confidence.

- **Central joystick** – controls forward, backwards and turning movements.
- **Mode button** – round button with three vertical lines, located to the right of the joystick. This button allows you to select the different modes available.
- **Pairing button** – round button with the Wi-Fi symbol, located to the left of the joystick. This button pairs the vehicle to the controller.
- **Indicator light** – shows charging and pairing status.



Different modes on the Remote Control Light Up Vehicle

The vehicle has three different modes which can be changed using the mode button on the remote control.

Mode 1 – Colour changing direction

In this mode (default mode), the vehicle changes colour depending on the direction it is moving.

- **Forward** – vehicle glows blue.
- **Backward** – glows green.
- **Turning right** – glows purple.
- **Turning left** – glows yellow.

This mode helps to clearly link movement with colour and direction.

Mode 2 – Fixed colour driving

- Press and hold the mode button for two seconds to activate mode 2.
- Press the mode button once (do not hold) to cycle through the seven colours available.
- When the desired vehicle colour is selected, use the joystick to start your journey.

In this mode, the vehicle will remain the same colour, regardless of direction.



Mode 3 – Colour scrolling mode

- Press and hold the mode button again for 2 seconds.
- The vehicle (if already in mode 2) will enter colour scrolling mode.
- Use the joystick to drive around while the vehicle displays a continuous sequence of changing colours.

Automatic safety and power features

Lift safety stop

If the vehicle is picked up during play, the motor will stop. It will reactivate once the vehicle is placed back on the floor.

Sleep mode

If the vehicle or remote control are not used for 5 minutes, both will automatically enter sleep mode to preserve battery power. Switch them on again to continue play.

Safe charging

For safety, always remove the charging cable once charging is complete and keep cables out of reach of children.

Compatible glow accessories

The Remote Control Light Up Vehicle includes four seats. These can be used with other small world resources but have been specially designed to seat the Glow People.

A built-in tow bar at the back of the vehicle allows Glow Wagons (non-motorised two seater) or other resources to be attached and pulled using the power from the Remote Control Light Up Vehicle.

How to look after and clean your Remote Control Light Up Vehicle

- Wipe clean using a soft, clean, damp cloth.
- **Do not** immerse in water.
- Avoid using on a thick pile carpet or rug as fibres may interfere with the motorised wheels.
- Recharge regularly to maintain battery life.
- Store the vehicle and remote control together after use.
